Welcome to DPW's Interactive Map for stormwater projects!

About this Map

The Baltimore City Department of Public Works (DPW) is installing projects that will clean polluted water before it enters our waterways and provide other benefits to communities such as keeping neighborhoods cool, calming traffic, and bringing nature into communities. These projects help meet the requirements of the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) permit, which is part of the Clean Water Act.

Projects identification is being prioritized in communities considering health, equity, and physical feasibility. More information on the types of projects and how they were prioritized is available here in [English](#) and [Spanish](#).

Projects can be filtered by the type of project,

Use any of the **filters** to show only projects within a particular location or of a certain type. The dashboard will update based on your selection

Click the **layer button** to expand the **layers menu**. Once the layers menu is expanded (as shown), click the **eye icons** to turn different layers on and off.

Read and explore the links in the **left side panel** for background information and how to ask questions and provide feedback about any of the projects shown

The **dashboard** shows the number of projects by status. It will update automatically based on any filters you select

The **right side panel** contains the legend to help understand the symbols and colors on the map.
